

## FORENSIC SCIENCE COURSE INFORMATION

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**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** Course includes topics in modern forensic science including the understanding of analytical instrumentation, pathology, toxicology, and DNA analysis. Actual forensic cases will be discussed throughout the course in lectures and class discussions. Error analysis, reliability and predictability of results will be considered. This is an elective course however it is recommended that you have successfully completed chemistry or physical science with at least a B.

**REMIEDIATION:** Since all test are open note; retesting should not be necessary. If a student or I feels it is necessary he/she will have to complete all classwork and homework assignments before retesting.

**EXAM:** There will be a teacher made exam which will count 20% of your final grade for anyone who does not meet the criteria for exam exemption.

**ABSENCES/MAKE-UP WORK:** It is YOUR responsibility to make up missed work. There is a make-up work crate on the counter and it is YOUR responsibility to check. All handouts will be in the crate. You have 5 days for each day absent to make up your work. For example, if you are absent on Tuesday and return on Wednesday your make up work is due on the following Wednesday. If makeup work is not turned in on time you will receive a zero for those assignments. In addition you must write ABSENT ON DATE on top of all absent work to receive absent credit. Any work that was due on the day you were absent will be due the day you return. If you have questions, you will need to see me BEFORE or AFTER school NOT at the moment it is being collected.
